Over the last two decades Bob, along with his wonderful wife Freda (also a Holocaust survivor), has spoken to thousands of New Zealand students and teachers about the Holocaust, giving first-hand testimony and speaking about the dangers of antisemitism and prejudice. His story has been highlighted in the media thus providing education to thousands more.

In 2019 Bob was made a member of the New Zealand Order of Merit for services to the community and education. His tireless work, over many years, to Holocaust education, in a variety of ways, is invaluable to furthering the mission of the Holocaust Centre of New Zealand and is recognised by this honour.
