She is an Auckland-based historian and researcher of family and Holocaust history. Since 1994 Claire has been involved with the Auckland Holocaust Oral History Project recording testimonies from approximately 90 survivors who came to live in New Zealand. She compiled an excellent resource of the experiences of 13 Kindertransportees that eventually settled in New Zealand. Claire also undertakes speaking engagements.
