Associate Professor Inbal Megiddo:

Cellist Inbal Megiddo has performed as soloist with many of the great orchestras and in major concert halls around the world, including recitals in the Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall, and with the Berlin Symphony at the Philharmonie. Inbal is Senior Lecturer in Cello at the New Zealand School of Music—Te Kōkī.

Since arriving in New Zealand in 2011, Inbal Megiddo has been playing cello in the annual Kristallnacht Commemorative concerts and has provided extraordinary service to the Holocaust Centre of New Zealand and Holocaust remembrance in New Zealand, with her performance and planning of the concerts.

Her imperative to give voice to those who have no voice has added poignancy to the Kristallnacht commemorations. Inbal is a driving force in the programme arrangements and contributes immensely across the events, ensuring the memory of those who suffered and were murdered in the Holocaust are remembered through music.

At the New Zealand School of Music—Te Kōkī, Inbal teaches a course on 'Music and Conflict', offering an in-depth study of music created in response to war and suffering, with emphasis on composers who were persecuted during and/or have conveyed the horror of World War II and the Holocaust.

Inbal's work aligns strongly with the Centre's mission of Holocaust education and remembrance.
