An example of this the sheet music written by composer Pavel Haas. The unnamed suitcases represent the one million Jews that died whose names are not recovered. There is one suitcase name who is not Jewish Jane Haining. It is important for young people to know the stories of those who stood up for the wrongs that were being done to the Jewish community. Jane helped protect her Jewish school girls and died for that.
